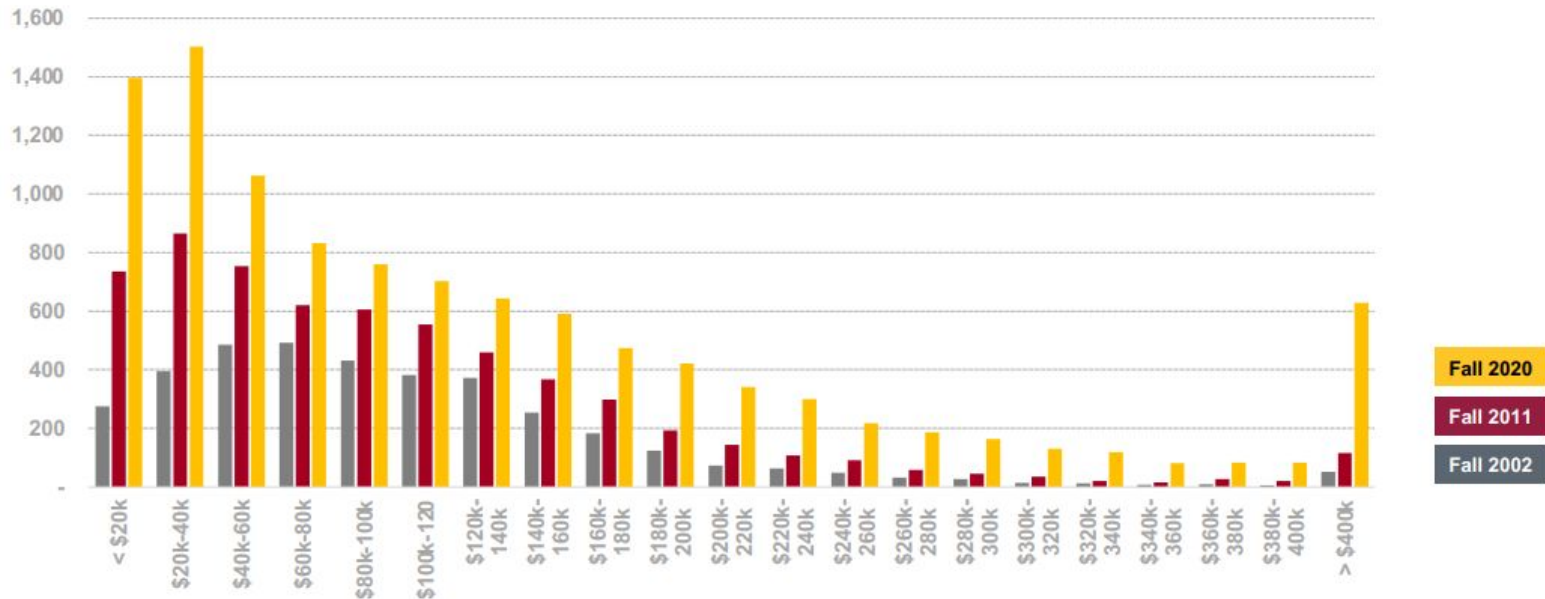
What we aim to do:

ASU is now more accessible to low-income students

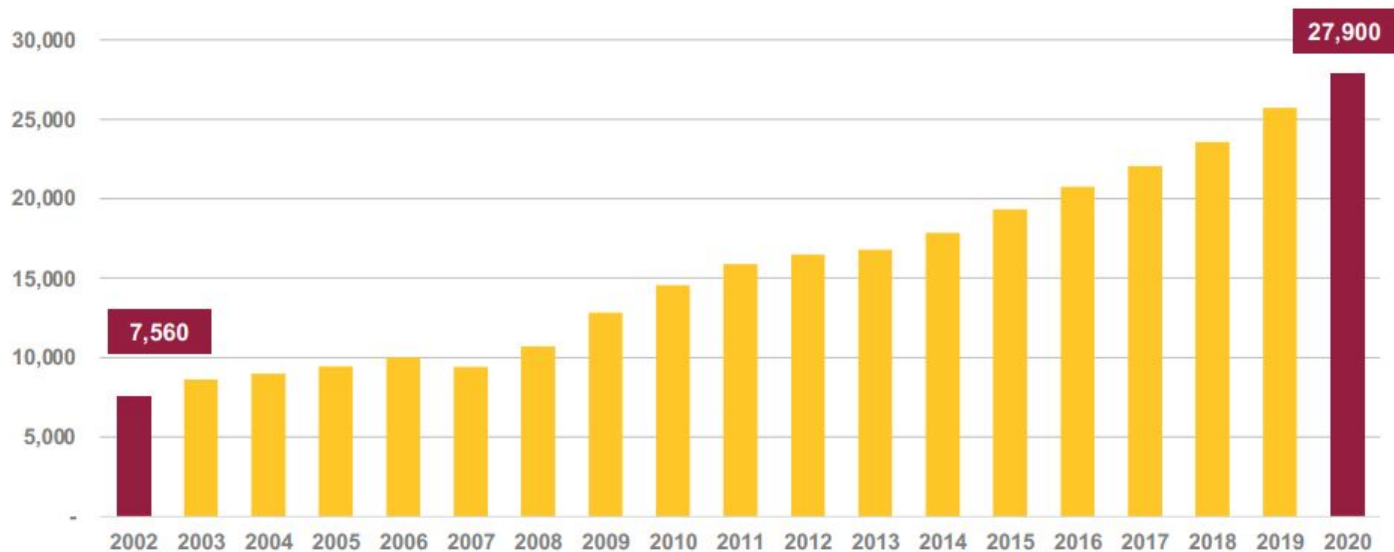
First-year enrollment by income (2002, 2011, 2020)

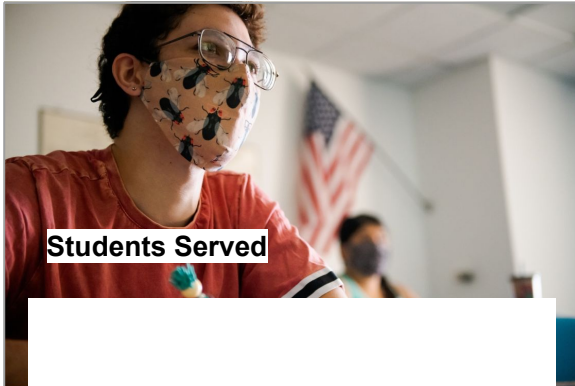
