Ohio's Long-Term Graduation Requirements

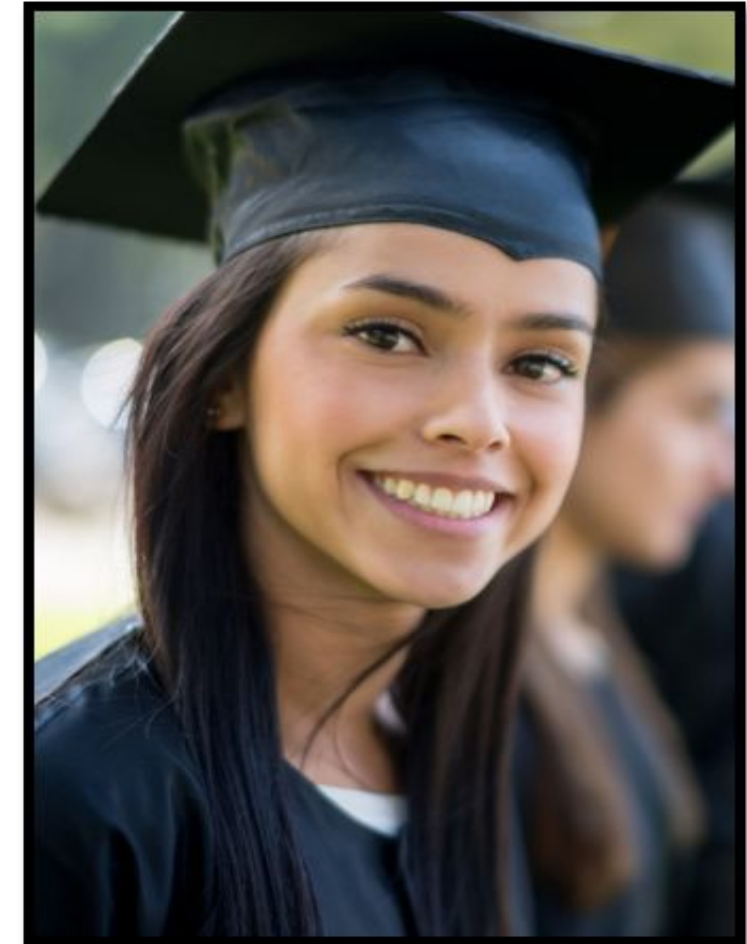
Students must meet requirements in all three areas



1. Course Requirements



2. Demonstration of Competency



3. Demonstration of Readiness

Competency on Ohio's State Tests:

Algebra I (or Integrated Math I) - 684
English Language Arts II - 684

Competency on Ohio's AASCD:

Mathematics – Basic (489)
English language arts – Basic (485)

Competency Alternative: Career Readiness

Complete 2 demonstrations to show competency, at least 1 must be a foundational option

Foundational Demonstration

- Cumulative score of proficient or higher on 3 or more WebXams in single career pathway
- Earn a 12-pt. approved industry-recognized credential or group of credentials totaling 12 pt. in one career field
- Earn a State issued license in a vocation that requires an examination
- Pre-apprenticeship or apprenticeship program
 - Registered with Ohio State Apprenticeship Council



Supporting Demonstration

- Complete 250-hours Work-based Learning
- Earn workforce readiness score on WorkKeys
- Earn the OhioMeansJobs Readiness Seal



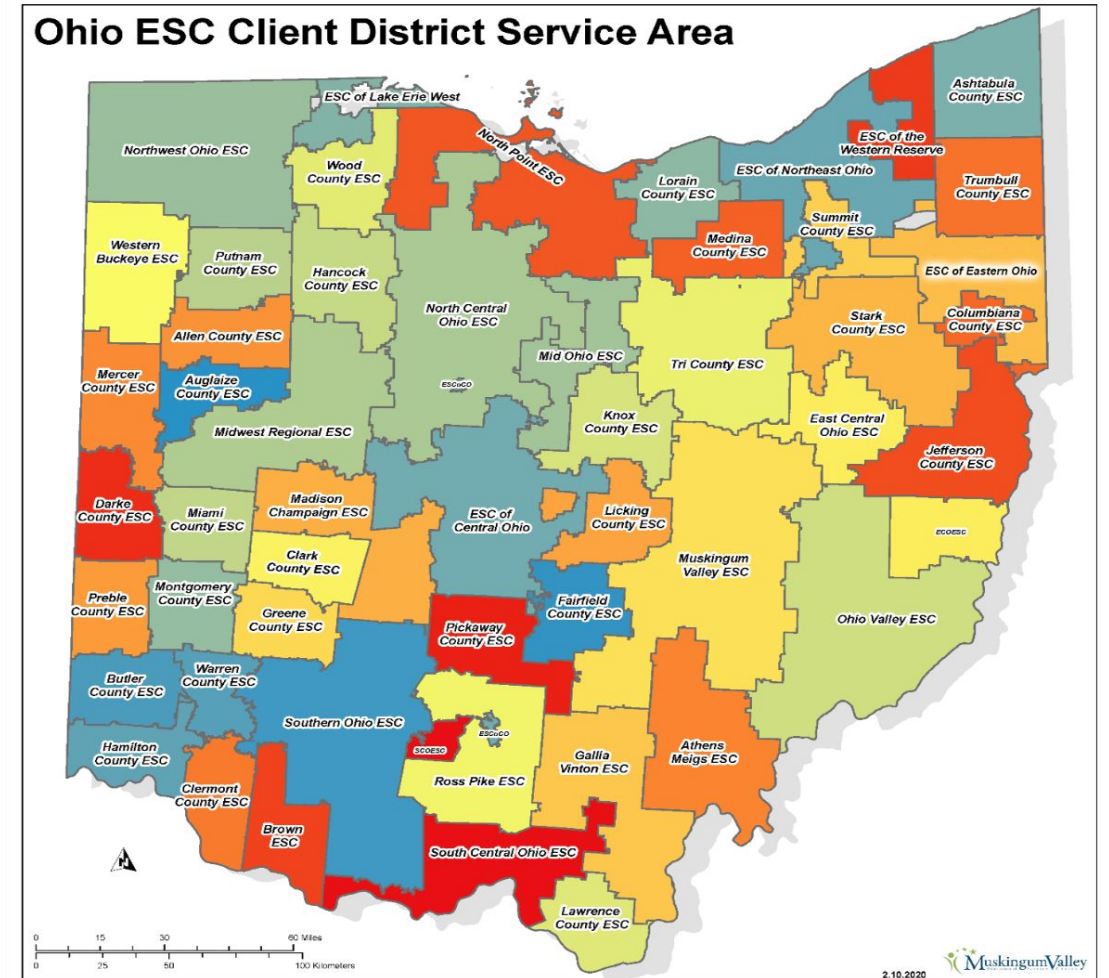

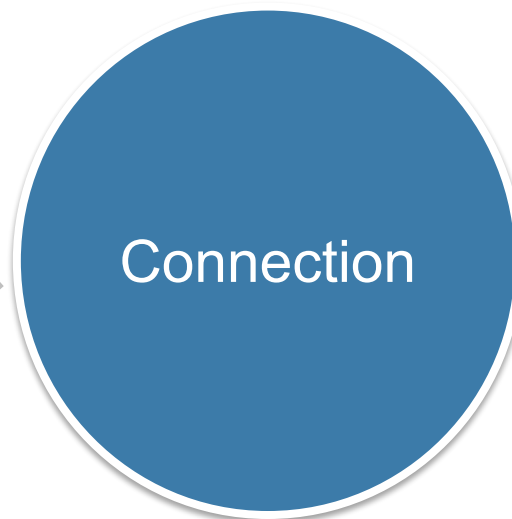
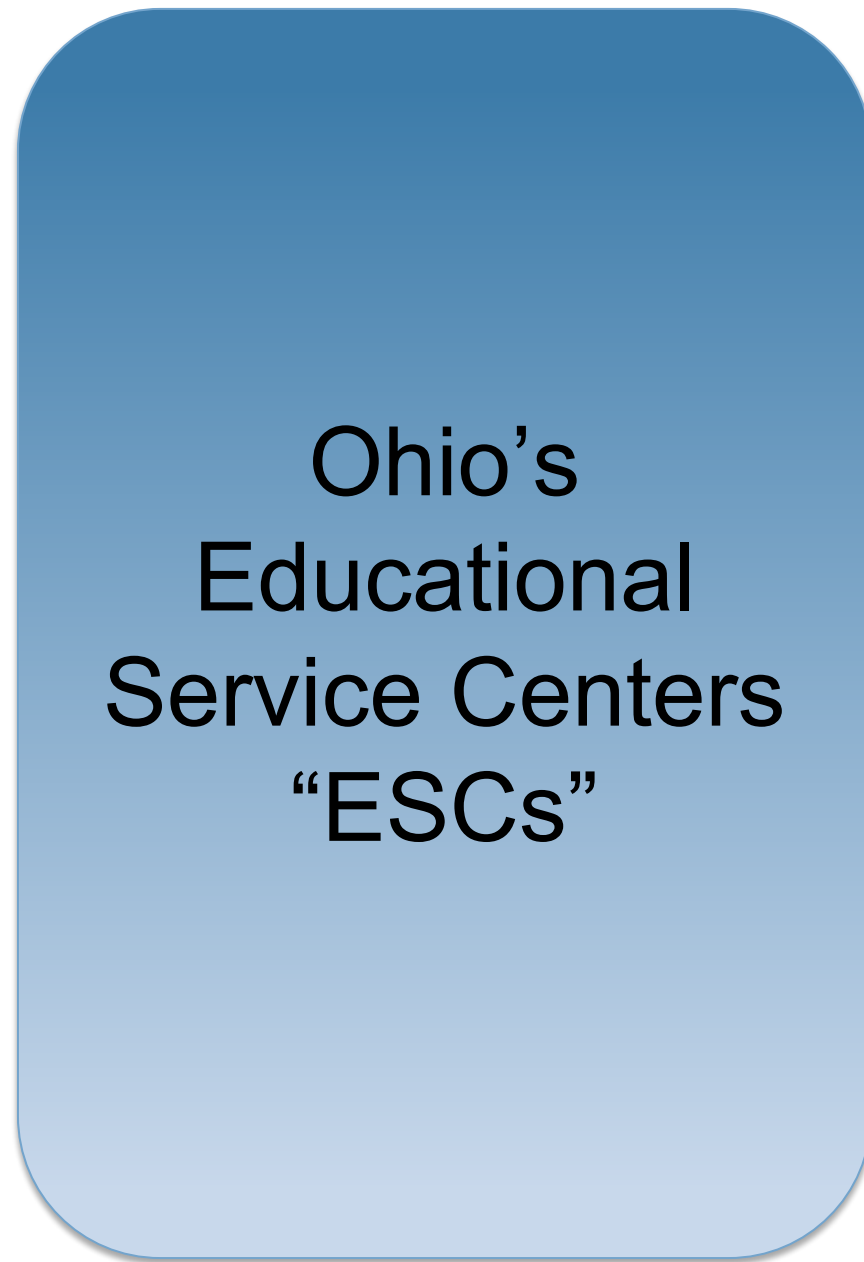


Educational Service Centers

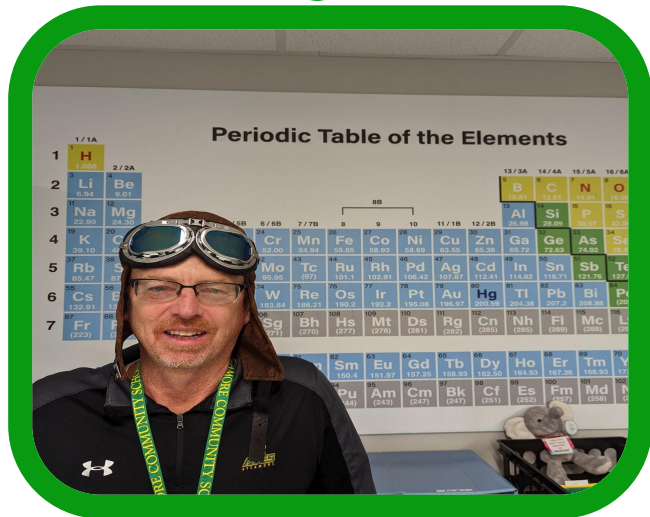

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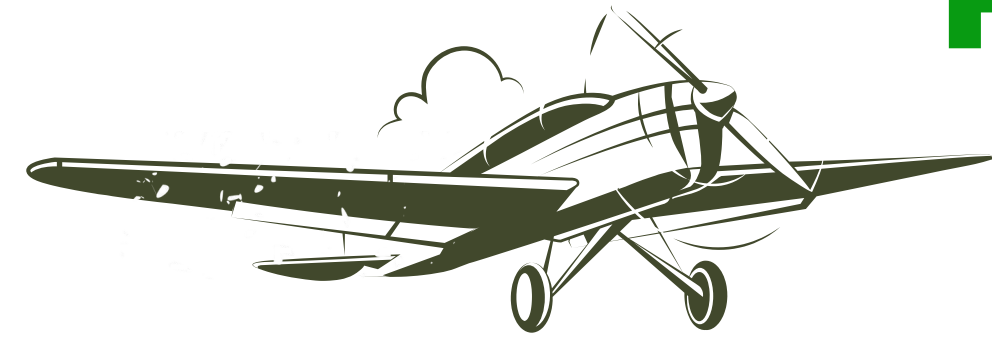

Most Impactful Pillar - Students at the Center

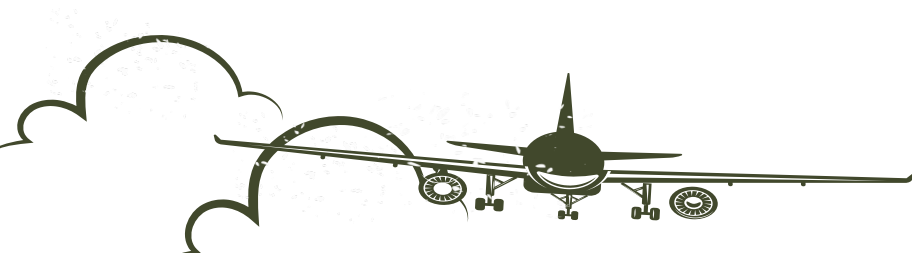
