AP/IB Program Goals:

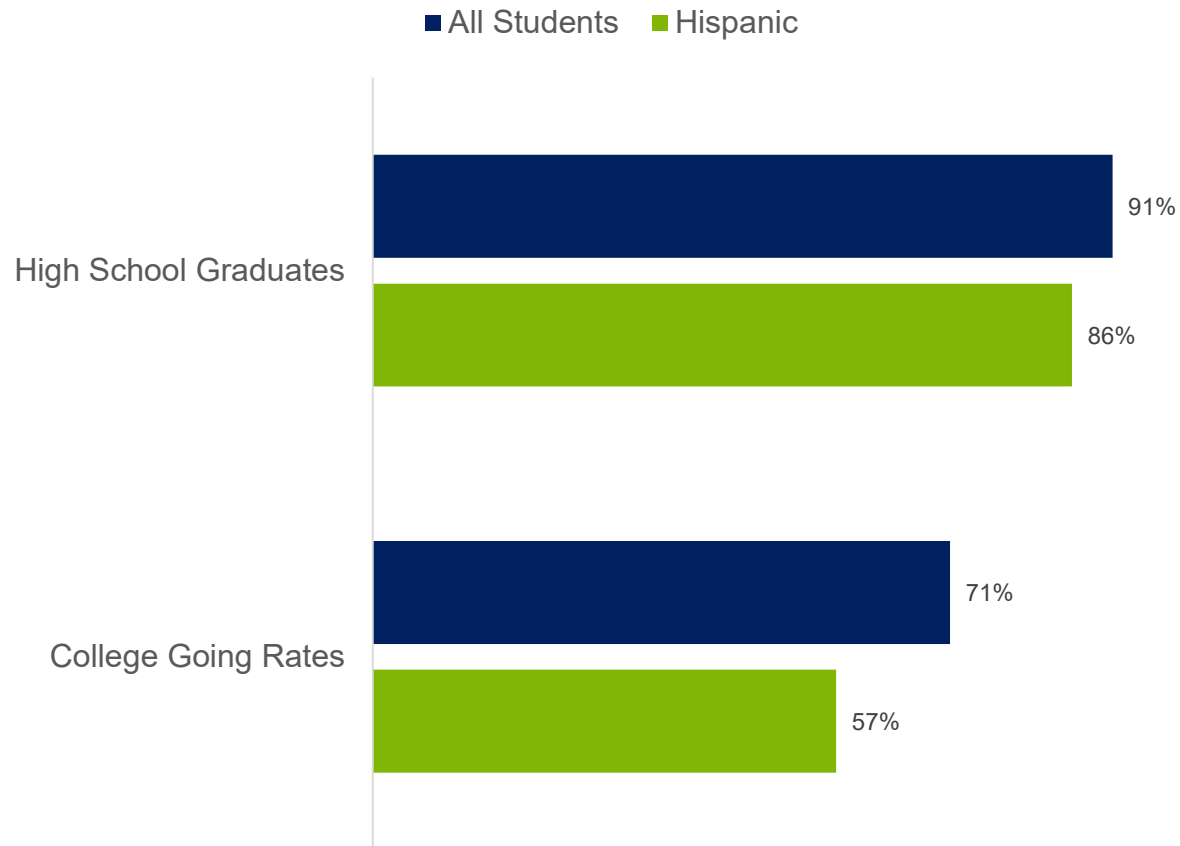
Improve AP/IB *participation* and *performance* for all student demographic groups and especially for our low-income and Hispanic students.

Encouraging students to enroll in even one rigorous course in their first 2 years of school can substantially improve graduation and 4-year college enrollment rates.

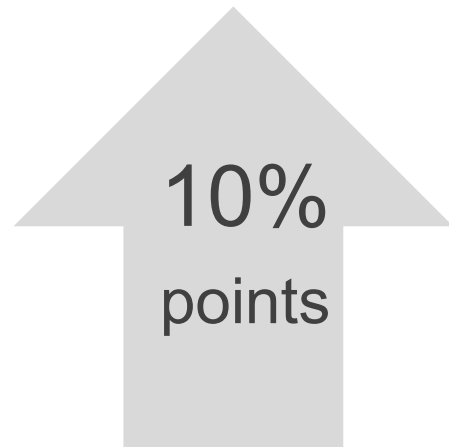

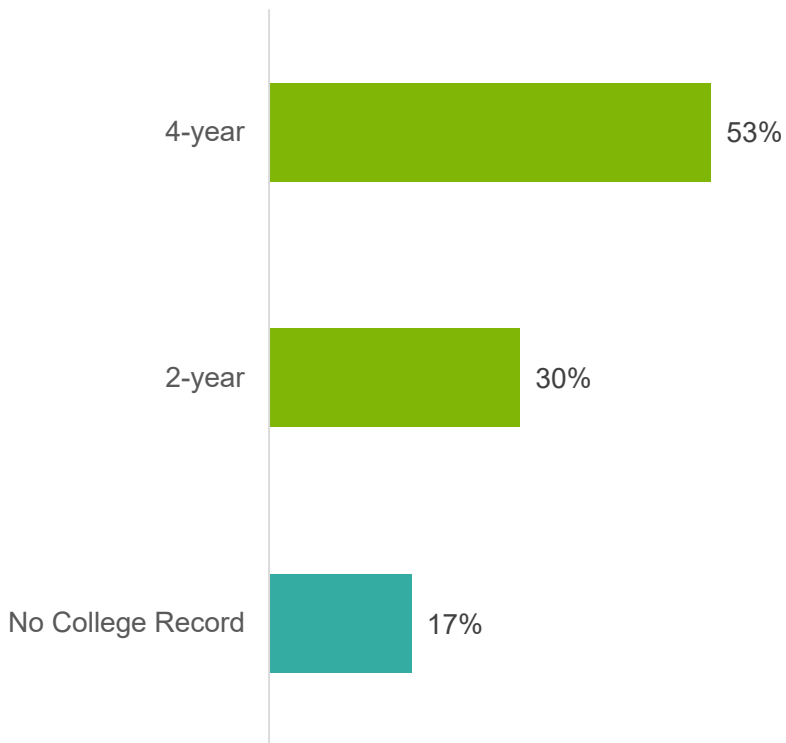
200 more students pass their AP/IB exam every year since we've started this initiative

■ 4-year ■ 2-year ■ No College Record



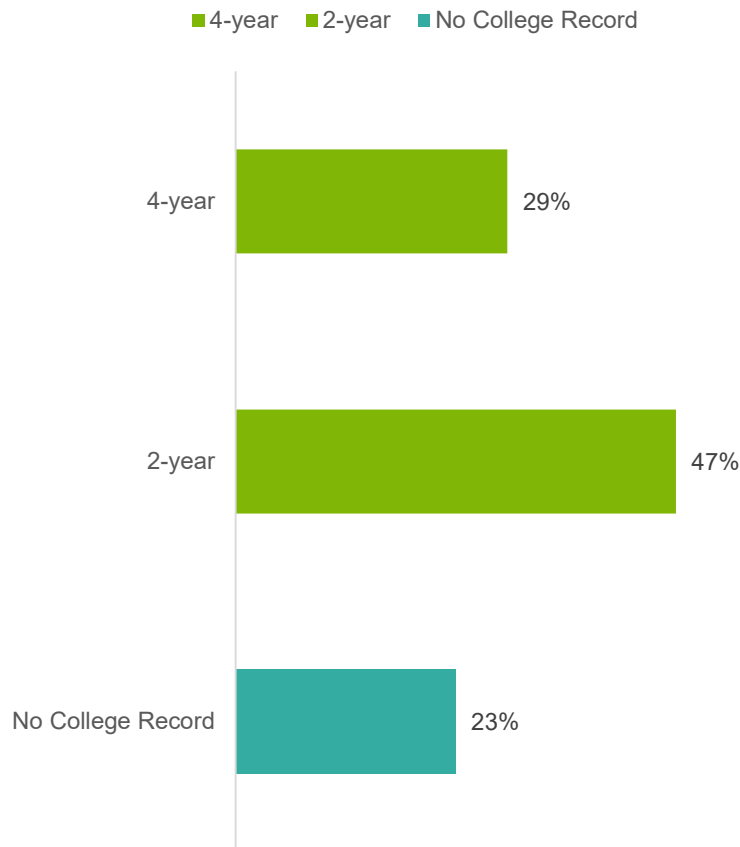
2017-18 Graduates NOT Enrolled in AP/IB in High School
