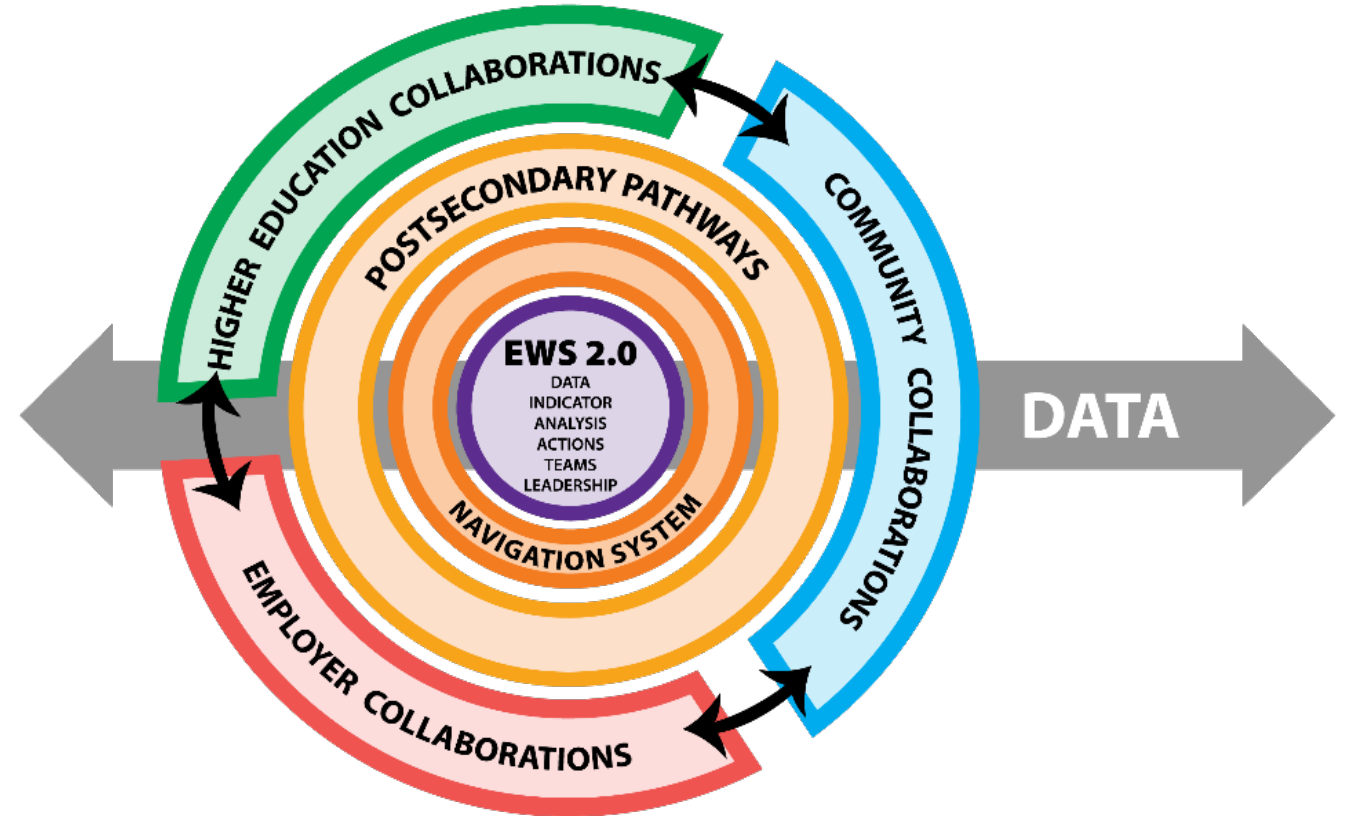
ORGANIZING OUR DISCUSSION
